



Announcement on the Launch of the Free Trade Unit (FTU) SWIFT BIC

Dear Clients,

In order to better support business related to the Free Trade Unit (FTU) and further enhance the efficiency of our international settlement services, our bank will officially activate a dedicated Free Trade Unit (FTU) SWIFT Code (hereinafter referred to as the "FTU BIC"): **UOVBCNSHFTU**.

With effect from today, all **Outward remittances** involving Free Trade Accounts will, by default, be processed using the above FTU BIC. For **Inward remittances** to Free Trade Accounts, we kindly request that you inform the relevant remitters in advance to select the above FTU BIC as the beneficiary bank's SWIFT Code when initiating the remittance, so as to ensure accurate payment instructions and smooth processing.

Please note that this FTU BIC is applicable exclusively to cross-border remittance transactions related to our bank's Free Trade Accounts. For other non-FTU business, please continue to use the existing payment route (SWIFT BIC: UOVBCNSHXXX), which remains unchanged.
