Login Password Security Enhancement (Updated)**

Dear Customer,

We are pleased to advise you that United Overseas Bank (China) Limited (“ the Bank”) had completed the system upgrade for the complexity setup of login password of Personal Internet Banking (“PIB”) & Mobile Banking (“MBK”) on 7 August 2016. The new rule of password setting will be applied to when you setup or change the password. It must be a combination of numeric and alphanumeric with the length of 8-24 characters.

You will be asked to change the password of PIB and/or MBK upon making the login, effect from 2:00am on 20 August 2016.
